Just like humans, dogs can suffer from seasonal allergies caused by pollen, dust, and mold. Signs include itching, sneezing, watery eyes, and irritated skin.

- Talk to your vet about allergy-friendly medications or supplements.
- Wipe down your pet after outdoor play to remove pollen.
