Why Spay or Neuter Your Pet?

- **Prevents Overpopulation:** Millions of animals end up in shelters every year, and many are euthanized due to lack of homes.
- Reduces Health Risks: Spaying females prevents uterine infections and breast tumors, while neutering males reduces testicular cancer risk.
- **Improves Behavior:** Less aggressive tendencies, reduced roaming, and fewer marking/spraying issues.

Common Myths About Spaying & Neutering

- "It Will Make My Pet Fat" Proper diet and exercise prevent weight gain, not hormones.
- "My Pet Should Have One Litter First" This is a myth.
 Early spaying reduces cancer risks.
- "It's Unnatural" Responsible pet care includes making decisions for their long-term well-being.

When is the Best Time to Spay/Neuter?

- **Puppies & Kittens:** Typically done around 8 weeks to 6 months.
- Adult Pets: Can be safely altered at any age with vet consultation.
- Senior Pets: May require additional health checks before surgery.

How to Get Assistance

 Check with your local shelter for low-cost spay/neuter programs.

- Some organizations offer financial assistance to pet owners in need.
- Vet clinics often run special promotions call and ask about discounts!
- There are several low-cost spay/neuter options available, besides local vet clinics. For instance, Dehart Veterinary Services. They provide very low cost pet wellness and high quality spay/neuter clinics at several locations around East Texas. 
